We will visit **Pokljuka Plateau**, a forested karst plateau at an elevation of around 1,100 to 1,400 metres located in the Julian Alps in northwestern Slovenia.

The plateau is known for its forests, mountain pastures, and winter sports facilities. It is also a common starting point for mountain hikers. The forested plateau is one of the most gorgeous areas of the Triglav National Park.

Forester at the Slovenian Forest Service will introduce close-to-nature forest management in predominantly spruce forests. We will walk through Peat Bog to learn more about the facts and importance of peat bogs that belong among the most precious natural areas in Europe.
